

The Messiah revealed in the Holy Scriptures.

Guidance for the use of this book.

The starting point is: Getting to know the Lord Jesus and getting to know Him better. How is that possible? By following the example of the Lord Jesus. – Luke 24:

*25 Then He said to them, "O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe in **all** that the prophets have spoken!*

*27 And beginning at Moses and all the Prophets, He expounded to them in **all** the Scriptures the things concerning Himself.*

It is about believing **all** that is written about the Lord Jesus in the books of Moses, in the Prophets and in the Psalms. This means in the entire OT.

How can you get to know the Lord Jesus and get to know Him better? By reading and believing everything that is written about Him. Jesus also taught the two men of Emmaus and His disciples in the same way. Let us follow His example. Pray that the Lord Jesus will open your mind and heart as you study His Word.

In your quiet time, start prayerfully reading this book. A few verses every day. What will you then discover?

- * His humility
- * His love to the Father
- * His grace and love in saving sinners
- * His omnipotence
- * His omniscience
- * His omnipresence
- * His obedience
- * His authority
- * His perfection

- * His tenderness and meekness
- His holiness and beauty
- His mercy, His goodness
- His office as King, Priest and Prophet
- His sacrifice to reconcile sinners with God
- His resurrection, ascension and second coming
- The unity of the OT and the NT
- The fulfillment of many prophecies

You can find it all in the book about the Messiah. There are 437 pericopes in total. Many people do not know that there is so much written in the OT about the Messiah. Neither Jews, nor Christians either. That is why explanation is necessary. The Lord Jesus knew that too and He explained the texts. Let us follow the example of the apostles and discover what is meant.
